We don't plan to give bags out FOR FREE as SidPac or Edgerton do, nor to subsidize continuously. More than 25 families showed interested in purchasing compostable bags at a subsidized price of 50bags/\$3. We are exploring options for bulk purchase (rounded& shipping included):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ECOSAFE (2.5gal): 720bags/\$90 (quality ok) 2. BIOBAGS (2.0gal): 600bags/\$100 (better quality). <p>Examples:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For ECOSAFE and 29 families: each gets 50bags/\$3, WEC subsidizes approx \$3 per family = \$90 2. For BIOBAGS and 24 families: each gets 50bags/\$3, WEC subsidizes approx \$5 per family = \$128. <p>Such a purchase should be enough at least for six months. Amounts can be lower, as we plan to ask for discounts and we are looking for better prices. In September, we may offer a non-subsidized purchase good for another six months, and so on.</p> <p>If WEC decision is to not subsidize, we will still offer families to purchase at the bulk price.
